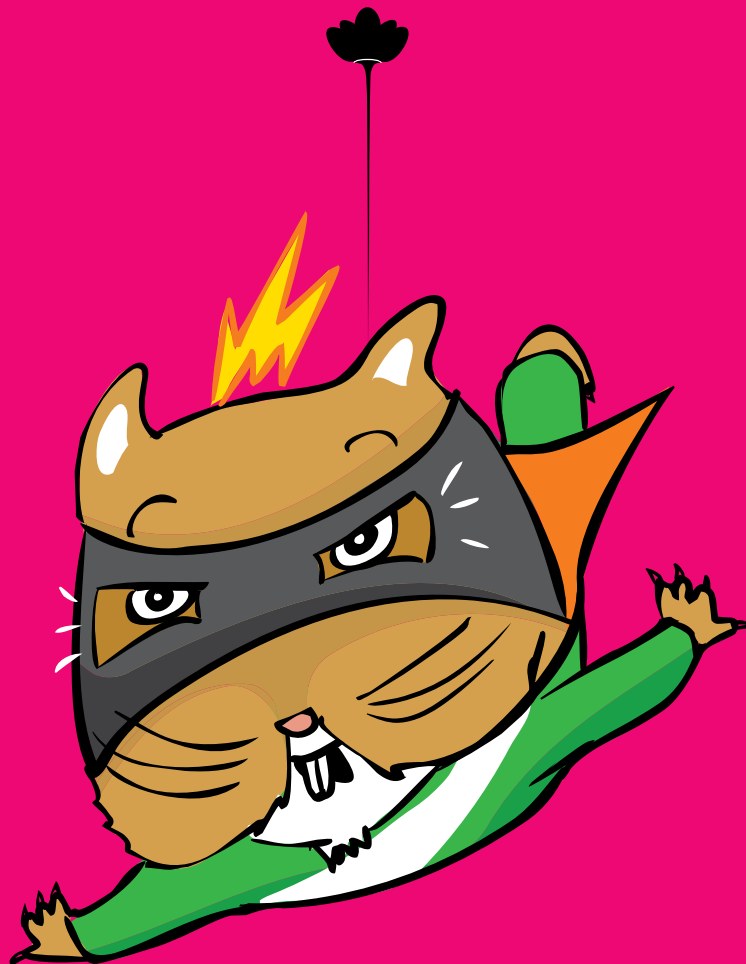

#7 SUPER GUINEA PIG GOES BACK TO THE FUTURE

(*Supermarsu palaa tulevaisuuteen*, Tammi May 2014, 125 pp.)

ELEVEN-YEAR-OLD EMILIA has a brilliant talent: one sip from her guinea pig's water bottle and she turns into Super Guinea Pig, a hero who uses her superpowers to do good and right wrongs. In the 7th part of the wildly imaginative children's book series, Emilia is sent to the future in a time machine, all the way to the 3000s.

TERESE BAST is an illustrator and graphic designer. She works on a wide variety of projects ranging from illustrations, her own series of postcards and stationery to the beloved Super Guinea Pig series.



SUPER GUINEA PIG SCORES A GOAL

(*Supermarsu tekee maalin*, Gummerus 2013, 136 pp.)

WHEN GREASE'S father, the margarine factory owner, plans to build a sports arena to replace the old football park, the fate of the park is decided in a football match between Emilia's frequently losing team and the star team sponsored by Grease's father.

SUPER GUINEA PIG AND THE SHRINKING SCHOOL

(*Supermarsu ja kutistuva koulu*, Gummerus 2011, 190 pp.)

EMILIA RECEIVES a letter from The Great Guinea, who orders the Super Guinea Pig to save the school at once. All is not what it seems.

SUPER GUINEA PIG AND THE STRANGE ASSISTANT

(*Supermarsu ja outo toveri*, Gummerus 2010, 190 pp.)

THE GREAT GUINEA wants Super Guinea Pig to grant three people their greatest wish so that people can start to believe in themselves again. She is allowed to recruit an assistant to help her.

SUPER GUINEA PIG RESCUES THE HERRING

(*Supermarsu pelastaa silakat*, Gummerus 2009, 187 pp.)

EMILIA'S BIGGEST Super Guinea Pig job ever is saving the Baltic Sea, a task that no-one else seems to be taking seriously. She gathers all of Finland's lakes into a super-sized garbage bag and brings them to a water treatment plant on Venus.

SUPER GUINEA PIG AND THE CASE OF THE TABLOID COW

(*Supermarsu ja lööppilehmän tapaus*, Gummerus 2008, 152 pp.)

EVERYONE IN Emilia's class at school is given their own animals and a task to create business ideas based on these animals. Emilia and Simo get Hilda the Cow, whom they decide to turn into the world's first celebrity cow.

SUPER GUINEA PIG FLIES TO INDIA

(*Supermarsu lentää Intiaan*, Gummerus 2007, 160 pp.)

EMILIA IS an ordinary 11-year-old girl living with her mother. When her mother gives her a long-awaited present, a guinea pig, something strange happens: the guinea pig bites her, and Emilia has an odd dream the following night.

Sinikka Nopola and Tiina Nopola have received several awards, including the State Award for Children's Culture, which acknowledges distinguished work in children's culture. Both are nominees for the 2014 Astrid Lindgren Memorial Award. Their bestselling book series feature some of the most beloved characters in Finnish literature: *Hayflower and Quiltshoe*, *Eric*, *Gecko and Puupponen* and *Ricky Rapper*, who is the country's most widely recognizable modern children's character.

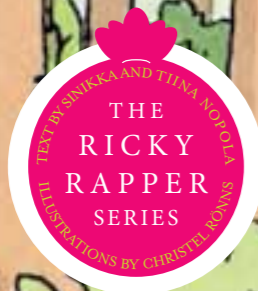


#13 RICKY RAPPER AND THE DOUBLE

(*Risto Rappääjä ja nukkavieru Nelli*, Tammi 2012, 116 pp.)



IN THE 12TH Ricky Rapper book, Ricky's best friend Nelly “Noodlehead” Butterfly needs help after her parents lose their jobs as television chefs. She is living in a caravan with her family, her clothes are full of holes and she doesn't even have money to buy ice cream. Ricky comes up with an idea to help Nelly's family, but can Nelly and Ricky realize the plan without getting into trouble?

RICKY RAPPER AND THE SCROOGE OF SEVILLE

(*Risto Rappääjä ja Sevillan saituri*, Tammi 2014)

FRAN RAPPER RECEIVES word of an elderly, fabulously wealthy relative who has heard of the musically talented Ricky and is contemplating giving him a large inheritance. Having come to Finland from his retirement home in Seville, he wants to meet Ricky, warning that the only musical genre he loathes is “that rap kids are listening to.” Fran and Serena begin to coach Ricky and Nelly for the meeting: rapping is forbidden, and a bowtie is mandatory.

THE RICKY RAPPER SERIES

THE RICKY RAPPER SERIES, launched in 1997, stars a red-headed boy who loves playing drums and rapping, and lives with his aunt Serena. Their circle of friends includes Ricky's best friend Nelly, Freezer Fran, Serena's boyfriend Mr. Lindberg and many others. Ricky Rapper's success in Finland is unparalleled in books for young readers. These bestsellers have been adapted into four movies, all of which have been box office hits in Finland, as well as plays, musicals and animated television programmes. Among Ricky Rapper's accolades has been inclusion in the 2002 IBBY (International Board on Books for Young People) Honour List.

CHRISTEL RÖNN'S (b. 1960) is an acclaimed illustrator and graphic designer whose innovative and humorous artwork has earned her several prizes and nominations, including the Finlandia Junior Prize in 2012. Rönns' wonderful illustrations have been part of Ricky Rapper's world since 2012.

WHEN SIRI'S MUM takes her baby things to the flea market, Siri holds on to her old binky for safekeeping. She decides to dress up her friend Little Otto as a baby. When he gets laughed at by his brothers Middle Otto and Big Otto, he gets angry and runs off. Not realizing that they were mocking their brother in disguise, the bigger Ottos promise to find a

replacement for the lost baby. Will Siri reveal who is really underneath the lace bonnet?

SIRI AND THE NAUGHTY STAR

(*Siiri ja tuhma tähti*, Tammi, Fall 2014)

SIRI'S FATHER has bought a telescope and taken up the hobby of star-gazing. When he tells Siri that one of the stars is named Sirius, she thinks it sounds just like her. She proudly tells her friends, the three Ottos, that she has her own star, but they are disbelieving and ask Siri to prove it. But what happens when the sky becomes hidden under a cover of clouds and Sirius doesn't reveal itself?

THE SIRI SERIES

SIRI IS a vivacious little girl whose three best friends are Little Otto, Middle Otto and Big Otto. The series, written by Tiina Nopola and illustrated by Mervi Lindman, has become known for representing the inner life of children in an authentic way: it narrates amusing everyday occurrences and emphasizes humour and imagination.

MERVI LINDMAN'S (b. 1971) vibrant illustrations are full of comical touches and details that bring the story to life and catch the attention of even the youngest readers. Lindman's works have been praised by critics and the public alike, and she has received several grants to support her artistic work.

In 2011 the Nopola sisters were both given the State Award for Children's Culture, which is Presented by the Arts Council of Finland and denotes distinguished work in children's culture. Both are nominees for the 2014 Astrid Lindgren Memorial Award.

HAYFLOWER, QUILTSHOE AND THE ANNOYING PEST

(*Heinähattu, Vilttitossu ja Littoisten riiviö*, Tammi 1999, rereleased in March 2014, 136 pp.)

The classic 8th entry in the series rereleased with new illustrations!

HAYFLOWER FEELS that Quiltshoe is always favoured over her, and decides to go on strike: she won't talk! Soon everyone in the family is noticing Hayflower. But who is the mysterious rascal of Littoinen, whom the village policemen are actively seeking to find? All clues lead to Hayflower, and she needs a waterproof alibi.

SALLA SAVOLAINEN (b. 1962) is an acclaimed and versatile illustrator who has worked on dozens of children's picture books. In 2005 she won the prestigious Rudolf Koivu Prize, and she was nominated for the H.C. Andersen Medal in 2010. Salla's wonderful illustrations have been part of the Hayflower and Quiltshoe world from 2012 on.



#14 HAYFLOWER, QUILTSHOE AND THE SASSY SCHOOLGIRL

(*Heinähattu, Vilttitossu ja ärhäkkä koululainen*, Tammi 2013, 69 pp.)

"I want to learn to write: 'the fishing trip has been cancelled,'" Quiltshoe said.

"A-ha, that's an intriguing sentence," Halise said.

HAYFLOWER HAS STARTED school, and the younger Quiltshoe becomes upset when she hears about her sister's class going on a fishing trip. She fetches a plan to make Hayflower and her parents believe that the outing has been canceled. The following day she dresses up as Hayflower and joins her sister's class on the trip...

HAYFLOWER, QUILTSHOE AND BIG ELSA

(*Heinähattu, Vilttitossu ja iso Elsa*, Tammi July 2014)

IT'S TIME FOR Quiltshoe to begin school. Her parents hope for her to turn into a conscientious little student like Hayflower, but when Quiltshoe is called names at school, she starts skipping class. Soon a mysterious note, written in chicken scratch, appears on the lamppost, promising services to care for and walk "cat and doogs, if u wantt." Hayflower begins to investigate why Quiltshoe is constantly getting "free study time" at school and coming home covered in dog hairs. An amusing chain of events follows, culminating in the arrival of a thief who isn't afraid of anything except dogs, ghosts and heights.

THE HAYFLOWER AND QUILTSHOE SERIES

THE RESPONSIBLE AND well-behaved Hayflower and the rowdy and free-spirited Quiltshoe are quite different to be sisters. The girls' family includes their mother, their loving but impractical father, and a little brother. Their adventures often involve their neighbors, the Misses Alibullen, and the two town policemen. The well-known stories have been adapted to the stage and the screen.

VILLE HYTÖNEN

Ville Hytönen (b. 1982) is a poet, children's book writer, bookshop owner, columnist and publishing director at Savukeidas Publishing, which he founded at the age of 19. He lives in Tallinn, Estonia. Hytönen's poems have been translated into 16 languages. In 2010 he received the Sammon Tekijät Award for new thinking, creativity and innovation. Awarded by the Finnish Ministry of Education and Culture, the prize is worth 50,000 euros. *Wonky Donkey* was nominated for the prestigious 2013 Finlandia Junior Prize, honouring the year's best children's book.

WONKY DONKEY

(*Hipinäaasi Apinahiisi*, Tammi 2013, 32 pp.)

TWO LONELY CREATURES – a donkey with weak lungs and a clumsy monkey – are both mocked and shunned by other animals because of their respective oddities. But what happens when the donkey and the monkey meet and decide that being wheezy or wonky are, in fact, qualities to proudly sing about?

MATTI PIKKUJÄMSÄ (b. 1976) has created illustrations for nearly a dozen children's books as well as several national magazines and newspapers in Finland. His visual language is defined by clear lines, stylized and expressive characters and bold colours. Among his accolades has been the 2012 Rudolf Koivu Prize, a biennial award given by the Association of Visual Communication Designers in Finland to an outstanding children's or YA book illustration.

Satu Kontinen (b. 1976) is a graphic designer and illustrator obsessed with little animals and Instagram photography. She is known for using strong and bold colors as well as creating creating quirky creatures and worlds of cuteness and beauty that spark the imagination of kids and adults alike. In 2008 she was given an award for designing and illustrating one of the most beautiful book covers in Finland (Vuoden kaunein kirja), and in 2004 she was nominated for the Finlandia Junior Prize.
